



# HOW MUCH DO YOU KNOW ABOUT THE KIDNEYS?





#### **Anatomy Lesson**

The kidneys filter waste and extra fluid from the body.<sup>2</sup>

Each kidney is made up of about a million filtering units called nephrons. Nephrons filter blood by pulling out waste and extra fluid which then becomes urine.<sup>2</sup>

## **By the Numbers**

#### 150-200 QUARTS

Blood circulates through your kidneys many times each day. In a single day, your kidneys filter about 150 - 200 quarts of blood.<sup>2</sup>

## **1-2 QUARTS**

About 1-2 quarts become urine.<sup>2</sup>
